Common drug risks in AKI/CKD

Renal

Review

- NSAIDs, aminoglycosides, vancomycin exposure, contrast in selected high-risk settings, RAAS blockers/diuretics during hemodynamic AKI, and other patient-specific nephrotoxins.

Action

- Confirm indication, dose by kidney function, monitor levels when applicable and avoid harmful combinations.

Restart

- Temporarily held chronic therapies should be deliberately reviewed for restart when clinically appropriate.
