

Thyroid Storm Checklist

Endocrine emergency sequence

Endocrine

PHYSICIAN REFERENCE

Recognize

- Severe thyrotoxicosis with fever, CNS dysfunction, marked tachycardia/AF, heart failure and GI/hepatic features.

Treatment sequence

- Beta-blockade when safe; thionamide; iodine after thionamide; corticosteroid; supportive care and precipitant treatment.

Escalate

- ICU-level monitoring; tailor beta-blocker choice carefully in heart failure/shock.
