Before and during anti-TB therapy

PHYSICIAN REFERENCE

Before

- Confirm diagnosis/site and drug susceptibility strategy; review weight, liver risk, interactions, pregnancy and HIV status where relevant.

Monitor

- Adherence, clinical response, hepatotoxicity symptoms, vision with ethambutol risk, neuropathy risk and drug interactions.

Public health

- Follow national TB program notification, contact and regimen guidance.

Clinical safety note

Use this as a memory aid, not a prescription. Verify current guidelines, local protocols, contraindications, renal/hepatic dosing, pregnancy status, interactions and patient-specific factors before treatment.
